

The last 'Muslim News' included a letter from Mr Umar Shah of London which articulated strongly felt beliefs on the treatment of Muslims in Britain. Mr Shah also claimed that 'some of the staff are spying on Muslim undergraduates' at our university. This is simply not true. The University's senior management recently met with members of our Muslim community to give that reassurance; such meetings take place regularly.
